

Bowtie Pasta Bow Tie

CROCHET PATTERN

Materials Needed:

- ♥ Pasta Colored Yarn (I used Redheart Super Saver in "Cornmeal")
- ♥ Size H us Crochet hook (5.00 mm)
- ♥ Medium Sized Button
- ♥ Yarn Needle

STITCHES USED:

- **♥** Single Crochet (SC)
- ♥ Slip Stitch (SlpSt)
- **♥** Chain stitch (Ch)
- ♥ Half Double Crochet (Hdc)

Bowtie:

ROW 1: Ch 3, Sc in the 3rd Ch from hook, Repeat 4 more times for a total of 5 ridges (15)

ROW 2: Sc 10 sts across the flat edge of the previous row (10)

ROW 3-17: Ch 1, Sc evenly across (10)

ROW 18: Ch 3, Sc in 3rd ch from hook, skip 1 st, SlpSt in next stitch. Repeat 4 more times (15) Fasten off.

Strap:

ROW 1: chain to the desired length (?)

ROW 2: Hdc across leaving 4 unworked chains at

the end, Ch 1, skip the next ch, Hdc in the next 3.

Fasten Off.

Weave in all your loose ends.

Sewing:

Fold the middle of your bowtie in to a zig zag shape and using a strand of yarn, stitch back and forth through it: don't fasten off! Go ahead and use your tail to sew the bowtie to the middle of the strap. Make sure it is secure and will not pull loose. Fasten off an weave in the tail.

Stitch your button on to the end of your strap that DOES NOT have the button hole, and make sure to seww it on the front side of the strap so when you curve it around it will be on the right side to button through the hole! Fasten off and your done!

Congradulations! Now go show off your glorious pasta tie to all your friends! And always remember to stay bold!
