



Amigurumi Pokeball Plush / Ornament



Grumpyskittles | 2017

Materials:

- Red, White, and Black yarn (I use Red Heart Super Saver).
- Crochet hook (I use a size F US hook)
- Scissors
- Yarn Needle
- Hot glue gun, and hot glue sticks.
- Fiber fill

Stitches You Need to Know:

- Single crochet = SC
- Single crochet increase = INC
- Single crochet two together = Sc2tog
- Slip Stitch = SLPST
- Chain = CH
- Magical ring = MR

Pokeball:

With red yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, 1 inc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, 1 inc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, 1 inc) x6 (36)

Rnd 7 – 9: sc around (36)

Change to black yarn here.

Rnd 10: sc around (36)

Change to White yarn here.

Rnd 11 – 13: sc around (36)

Rnd 14: (4 sc, 1 dec) x6 (30)

Rnd 15: (3 sc, 1 dec) x6 (24)

Rnd 16: (2 sc, 1 dec) x6 (18)

Rnd 17: (1 sc, 1 dec) x6 (12)

Dec around until the hole is closed.

FO and weave in the tail.

Button:

With white yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc around (12)

Change to black yarn.

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x6 (18)

FO and weave in the tails.

Using your hot glue gun, glue the “button” to the Pokeball. Make sure to glue it on the seams of the color changes so that they are no longer visible.

BONUS: Tie a loop on top to turn your plush into a Christmas tree ornament!
